About Mary

Mary Jeanne Kennedy Anderson was a retired Madisonarea nurse who served on the Catholic Charities Diocese of Madison



board of directors and various committees. She was a devoted mother of five and grandmother of nine who enjoyed volunteering and directing her energies to helping others. She passed away on Dec. 6, 2013 from ovarian cancer. The Mary Jeanne Kennedy Anderson Youth Faith in Action Scholarship was established by her family and Catholic Charities in 2014.



2024-25 Application Requirements

Catholic Charities Diocese of Madison's Mary Jeanne Kennedy Anderson Youth Faith in Action Scholarship recognizes two high school seniors who have shown a commitment to community service with \$2,000 scholarships. Applicants will be evaluated on their past and current parish/pastorate and community service, leadership roles, and commitment to putting their faith in action in the future.

Application Deadline: Dec. 13, 2024

Residency: Diocese of Madison

<u>Academic</u>: High school senior during the 2024-2025 academic year; Plans to attend a college, university or technical school in 2025; Minimum GPA of 3.0

<u>Criteria</u>: Current member of a Diocese of Madison parish/pastorate; Parish/ pastorate and community service, including leadership roles; Commitment to a future that encompasses a dedication to their faith in action.

<u>Awards</u>: Two awardees per year, \$2,000 scholarship per awardee. Scholarships

will be presented to recipients by Bishop Donald Hying and Catholic Charities Executive Director Shawn Carney on Sunday, Feb. 9, 2025 at Frassati Fest in Wisconsin Dells.

Application Materials:

1. Scholarship Application Form

2. *Essay:* A 300- to 400-word, typed essay describing a) how you have put your faith in action, b) how you will continue to put your faith in action in your life and c) the importance this holds for you and your community.

3. Personal Reference Questionnaire: The questionnaire must be completed by a priest, deacon or director of religious education indicating your level of parish/ pastorate involvement.
