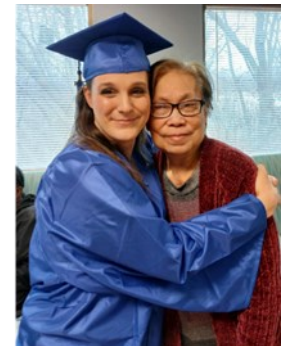

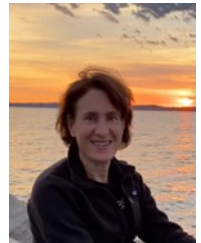
Happy Anniversary

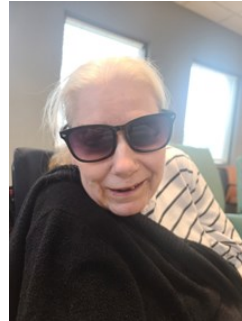
