every member of the team.

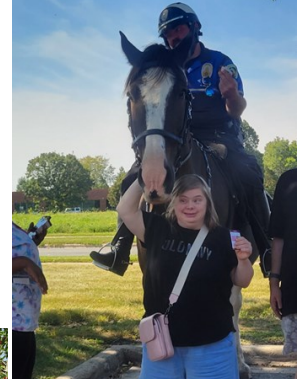
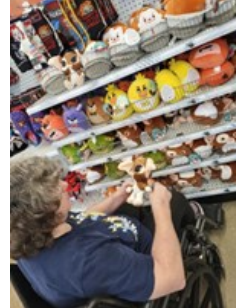

Costumes encouraged—let's make this Halloween one to remember

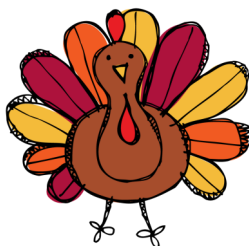
Adult Day Center Annual Thanksgiving Party
