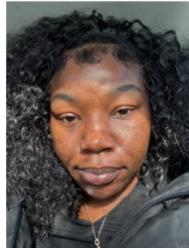
A little prevention goes a long way, wash your hands, get plenty of rest, stay hydrated, and take care of yourself to help keep those seasonal bugs at bay!

I'm so happy to be part of the team, and I look forward to getting to know everyone better!.

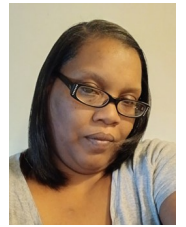
